### IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

*Following the recent installation of our new 147.195 MHz Yaesu System Fusion DR2X repeater, which is owned and operated by the Dubois County Emergency Management Agency, we will be using C4FM/Digital to conduct directed Skywarn nets during local Skywarn operations. C4FM/Digital has dramatically improved the reliability of our communications and has overcome noise issues that previously degraded our communications. To facilitate easy access to our communications regardless of the mode we are using, we are now streaming our audio over Broadcastify and cell phone scanner apps allowing world-wide access. During day-to-day operations, our repeater remains open for all amateurs to use in whatever format they choose.*
