IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

The 147.195 MHz repeater, which is owned and operated by the Dubois County Emergency Management Agency, has been upgraded to a Yaesu System Fusion DR2X supporting both FM/analog and C4FM/digital. Since the repeater's C4FM/digital capability has overcome serious noise issues, the Dubois County EMA is now using C4FM/digital to communicate with its staff of trained weather spotters while severe weather is moving through locally. All communications on the 147.195 MHz repeater, both analog and digital, are now being streamed over Broadcastify allowing 24/7 world-wide access. The 147.195 MHz repeater remains open for all amateurs to use during day-to-day operations in whatever mode they choose.
