### IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

The 147.195 MHz repeater, which is owned and operated by the Dubois County Emergency Management Agency, has been upgraded to a Yaesu System Fusion DR2X supporting both FM/analog and C4FM/digital. The repeater's C4FM/digital capability has overcome serious noise issues and dramatically improved the reliability of our communication. As a result, Dubois County EMA is now using C4FM/digital during Skywarn operations while threatening weather is moving through locally to support critical communications with our staff of trained weather spotters. To easily access to our communications, regardless of what mode we are using, we are now streaming our audio over Broadcastify and cell phone scanner apps providing world-wide access. During day-to-day operations our repeater remains open for all amateurs to use in whatever mode they choose.
