Dubois County Skywarn uses FM/analog on our 147.195 MHz Emergency Management repeater to keep weather spotters and stations aware of severe weather in the area. However, when a warning is issued for Dubois County threatening lives and property, our Skywarn nets are conducted using C4FM/digital enabling 100% noise free, crystal-clear communications with our local team of trained spotters who provide vital severe weather and storm damage reports within Dubois County. All communications on the repeater, both analog and digital, are live streamed over Broadcastify 24/7 allowing world-wide access by all amateur radio operators and the public.
